Mollie Stone's Donates \$4,372 To Paint The Castro Red To Support Local HIV/AIDS Service Organizations

Proceeds allocated from sales at Mollie Stone's Castro store on World AIDS Day

It is estimated that over \$35,000 was raised for HIV/AIDS non-profit organizations including AIDS Emergency Fund, AIDS Legal Referral Panel, Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center, Maitri, National AIDS Memorial Grove, Positive Resource Center, Project Inform, Project Open Hand, San Francisco AIDS Foundation, Shanti and Visual Aid. Statistics from the San Francisco Department of Public Health indicate that 15,861 San Franciscans were living with HIV/AIDS at the end of 2010, with 400-500 newly diagnosed HIV cases each year.
